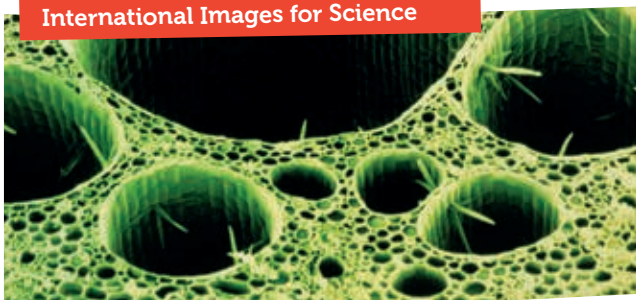
Rebel Daughters

The Rebel Daughters group exhibition celebrates the passions and interests of over 60 women artists to mark the centenary in 2018 of women first getting the right to vote. Featured work includes the resin cast of a pig's head 'Teacher's Pet' by Michelle Clarke Stables to exquisite underwater photographs retelling the story of Shakespeare's 'Ophelia' by Nicola Jayne Maskrey and photographs from the 'Defying Conventions' series by Shannon Langley, placing girls at the heart of a revolution.
